FESTIVAL AWARDS 2024

The Awards Ceremony for the 21st edition of the Crossing Europe Film Festival Linz took place today in the Ursulinensaal at OK Linz, with Miriam Hie hosting the atmospheric evening.

In the presence of jury members, numerous film guests, industry representatives and the trade press from Austria and abroad, as well as representatives of funding partners, sponsors and representatives of cultural policy – a.o *Gertraud Scheiblberger*, State deputy, on behalf of the Governor of the Federal Province of Upper Austria Thomas Stelzer, *Dietmar Prammer*, City Councilor, on behalf of Mayor Klaus Luger, *Theresa Ganhör*, Municipal Councilor, on behalf of City Councilor Doris Lang-Mayerhofer, *Michael Brauner*, Gutenberg-Werbering, *Liliana Nelska*, VdFS, *Marco Zinz*, Managing Director The Grand Post – Post Production Houses, *Solenn Durmord* (Les Arcs Film Festival, France) & *Joshua Jádi*, FilmFestival Cottbus, Germany – on behalf of MIOB – Festival Network Moving Images Open Borders – the CROSSING EUROPE AWARDS (cash & non-cash prizes worth € 28,500) and the MIOB New Vision Award 2024 (€ 3000) were presented, festival directors Sabine Gebetsroither and Katharina Riedler drew a positive balance.

The JURY COMPETITION - Fiction (Ivan Bakrač, Solenn Durmord & Barbara Wurm) justified their decision with the words:

"Our choice might not seem obvious. Nothing obvious in this film anyway. Every shot a tiny mystery, a slight move forward in life, a step towards embracing the world (nearly invisible, though so brave). The people in this film are calm, with their grief over loss and layers of emotion hidden deep inside their bodies. Their faces, gestures, and sometimes even words (after taking a deep breath) become the window to fellow human beings and the world they share, we share. It is a film about transmission on every level. Moderate in ambience, minimalist in style, sober in display and action, and pretty silent throughout – this movie touched us as if unconciously. It is the warmth that comes from this caretaking of frozen bottles of nutrition, the lightness in times of darkness, the search for

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common ground in lonely moments, which makes this film, daringly directed, and incredibly performed by Frieda Barnhard, an unforgettable image of belongingness. What a wonderful world of ours this would be, were it full of humans like Robin, a woman whose inner rebellion and strong sense of recognition transforms into something far beyond the usual or obvious, a path of witty vitality and honest dignity. The main award of the Competition Fiction goes to MELK by Stefanie Kolk."

THE HUMAN HIBERNATION

Anna Cornudella Castro, ES 2024, 90 min

"With breathtaking precision in grading and framing, while visually remaining in the sphere of grainy solution and the darker side of the moon, this film is a real piece of cinematographic art, one that combines the deep devotion for all earthly creatures with sheer endless poetic creativity, the highest image- and sound-based sensitivity, and the explorative power of a hybrid, fragmentary, loosely sketched transrational yet natural narration. Our special mention goes to Anna Cornudella Castro's THE HUMAN HIBERNATION – for flying us to the moon!"

The JURY COMPETITION - Documentary (Diego Armando Aparicio, Ketevani Kapanadze & Marek Kozakiewicz) phrased its reasoning with these words:

"We watched 11 films in the documentary competition this week. Each brought to light very different stories, revealing many of the challenges Europe has faced for decades and has yet to overcome: gender inequality, ecological catastrophes, deficiencies in social care systems, disparities in class, and an unresolved guilt from its colonial past which still feels very present in today's raging refugee crisis and ongoing warfare. We learned a lot from all the films, but there was one film in particular that truly spoke directly to our hearts. Set against a backdrop of systemic violence and state oppression, this work reminds us that our shared humanity will always outlive the social structures that fail us. The film exudes warmth and reveals the hidden beauty of its protagonists beyond their

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flaws, serving as an affirmation to life itself. Through its sincere observation of two unlikely companions, the viewer experiences a human closeness that is characteristic of only the finest works of documentary filmmaking, delivered with respect and empathy."

The JURY COMPETITION – Local Artist (Elisa Andessner, Joshua Jádi & Nana Thurner) reached the following decision:



"This year's Crossing Europe Award – Local Artist goes out to a documentary that focuses on a female athlete. What captivated us was the sober portrayal of the hard everyday training routine. It was the self-contained cinematic language that actually touched us and made us feel the protagonist's discipline, will power, and isolation. The necessary tension is created by the relationship between trainer and athlete. It is a film that presents a woman with a fighting spirit who unites physical power, tactics, and aggressiveness. The award goes to MARLENE by Daniel Kalkhofer."
