The ray Audience Award goes to Alexis Dos Santos for **UNMADE BEDS**.

The **CROSSING EUROPE Award Local Artist** is this year split into a cash prize and a non-cash prize and awarded to MARTIN MUSIC for **DRAUF** and Harald Hund & Paul Horn for **DROPPING FURNITURE**; a **Special Mention** goes to Steinerkirchen secondary modern school for **ROMEO UND JULIA (FRANZ UND ROSI)**.

The CROSSING EUROPE Award 2009 European Competition powered by Linz 2009 European Capital of Culture, endowed with 10,000 euro, goes to **UZAK IHTIMAL/WRONG ROSARY** (TR, 2009) by Turkish director **MAHMUT FAZIL COSKUN**. A **Special Mention** goes to the Swedish film **DE OFRIVILLIGA/INVOLUNTARY** (SE, 2008) by Ruben Östlund. UNMADE BEDS (GB, 2008) by **Alexis Dos Santos** has won the hearts of the audience and is awarded the ray Audience Award powered by ray film magazine, endowed with 5,000 euro. The **CROSSING EUROPE Award Local Artist** (6,000 euro) funded by the Federal Province of Upper Austria (4,000 euro) and Synchro Film- und Videobearbeitung (2,000 euro) is split this year. **Martin Music** receives the cash prize (4,000 euro) for **DRAUF**. The non-cash prize (2,000 euro) goes to the film **DROPPING FURNITURE** by **Harald Hund** and **Paul Horn**.

Furthermore the jury – Barbara Musil (A), Edith Stauber (A) and Hermann Greuel (NO) – has awarded a Special Mention to the animation film **ROMEO UND JULIA (Franz und Rosi)** by the **Steinerkirchen secondary modern school**.
