AWARDS PRESENTATION - CROSSING EUROPE 2010

for VIDEOCRACY.

Zvonimir Jurić and Goran Dević are the winners of the Competition European Cinema and receive the CROSSING EUROPE Award European Competition 2010 for CRNCI/THE BLACKS.

Winner of the ray Audience Award is Séverine Cornamusaz with COEUR ANIMAL HEART.

Erik Gandini receives the CROSSING EUROPE Award European Documentary, awarded for the first time this year,

The CROSSING EUROPE Award Local Artist is divided this year into a money prize and a material prize and goes to Michaela Mandel for SINISTER SISTERS SLAUGHTERHOUSE and to Ella Raidel for SLAM VIDEO MAPUTO.

The CROSSING EUROPE Award Local Artist – Atelier Award is also presented for the first time this year, specifically now to Gloria Gammer & Sigrid Nagele for THE LAW OF THE TIME – RITORNELL.

The CROSSING EUROPE Award European Competition 2010 with prize money of 10,000.- Euro goes to the two directors Zvonimir Jurić und Goran Dević for CRNCI/THE BLACKS (CR, 2009). The international festival jury – Matthieu Darras (FR), Nerina T. Kocjancic (SI) and Labina Mitevska (MK) – praised the powerful visualization of an extreme situation as well as the brave approach to a controversial topic.

COEUR ANIMAL/ANIMAL HEART (CH/FR, 2009) by **Séverine Cornamusaz** found the most favor among the audience and was distinguished with the **ray Audience Award** with promotional surface with a value of 5,000.- Euro. Voting members of the audience are eligible for a drawing for a trip to Dok Leipzig – Int. Leipzig Festival for Documentary and Animated Film in October 2010.

VIDEOCRACY (SE 2009; D: Erik Gandini) has been awarded the CROSSING EUROPE Award European Documentary (powered by ORF), presented for the first time this year, which comprises the purchase of TV broadcasting rights by ORF.

The **CROSSING EUROPE Award Local Artist with a total value of 6,000.**– **Euro**, donated by the Federal Province of Upper Austria/Culture (4,000.– Euro) and Synchro Film, Video und Audio Bearbeitungs GmbH, Vienna (voucher with a value of 2,000.– Euro) is divided this year. For **SINISTER SISTERS SLAUGHTERHOUSE** (AT/SE 2009), which impressed the jury – Claudia Dworschak, Martin Music and Dominik Tschütscher – "with its precise haptic realization, in which the hand of the filmmaker literally-pictorially intervenes in the events."

Michaela Mandel is awarded the money prize (4,000.- Euro). The material prize (2,000.- Euro) goes to **SLAM VIDEO**MAPUTO (MZ/AT 2009) by **Ella Raidel**, which according to the jury "eavesdrops on the rituals of media staging in pictures, positions herself in between and thus demonstrates what documentation is capable."

The CROSSING EUROPE Award Local Artist – Atelier Award (powered by Atelierhaus Salzamt) is also awarded for the first time this year, specifically now to Gloria Gammer & Sigrid Nagele for THE LAW OF THE TIME – RITORNELL, who will be provided with atelier space in the Salzamt for twelve months.
