FESTIVAL AWARDS 2018

The Awards Presentation of the anniversary edition (15 Years!) of the CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz took place today in the Ursulinensaal of the Upper Austrian Culture Quarter, moderated by Markus Zett, who proved again to be a charming, charismatic host.

With numerous international film guests, industry representatives, press, and representatives of the funders, sponsors and politics – including City Councilor Doris Lang-Mayerhofer, City Councilor Gerhard Weixelbaumer, gfk Managing Director Wiltrud Katharina Hackl, Patrick Bartos (Managing Director CREATIVE REGION Linz & Upper Austria), Marco Zinz (Managing Director The Grand Post – Audio & Picture Post Production) and Alexander Fischbacher (Managing Partner The Grand Post – Audio & Picture Post Production), Jörg Schiffauer (ray film magazine) and the artistic director of the Upper Austrian Culture Quarter, Martin Sturm – the CROSSING EUROPE AWARDS (money & material prizes with a value of about € 29.000,-) were presented, Festival Director Christine Dollhofer gave a preliminary positive assessment of the festival.

The JURY COMPETITION – Fiction (Stefan Butzmühlen, Václav Kadrnka, Martha Otte) explained their decision with the words:

"From a classic literary starting point, this film opens the door to a surprisingly well-structured, multi-layered world. It liberates both characters and audience from narrative convention, resulting in a joyful film experience. The main prize goes to Leonardo Mouramateus for ANTÓNIO UM DOIS TRÊS / ANTONIO ONE TWO THREE.



A father sees his teenage daughter's talent as a vehicle to change his own social fate in an otherwise hopeless setting. Without judgement, the filmmakers test the boundaries of realism in this intense cinematic study. The special award ex acqueo goes to Silvia Luzi and Luca Bellino for IL CRATERE / CRATER.

With his rich cinematic palette, the director creates a slightly absurd, dystopian yet humanistic reflection on a contemporary society at the edge of Europe. The special jury award ex acqueo goes to Emre Yeksan for KÖRFEZ / THE GULF."

The JURY COMPETITION – Documentary (Zdeněk Blaha, Magali Rocaut, Oliver Sertić) said in their statement: "We decided to give the award to the film which reveals an alarming problem. Today 45 million people work as modern slaves, completely hidden from the sight of society. But what is even more disturbing, there is no political will of modern so-called democracies to do anything about this social issue. We admire how the author managed to gain the trust of her protagonist who had lost trust in everyone else. We also appreciate that the process of filming became a process for the character to realize, rethink and find will and strength to deal with her situation. An emotionally moving and honest film about regaining the dignity of a human being. We decided to award A WOMAN CAPTURED by Bernadett Tuza-Ritter."

The JURY COMPETITION – Local Artist (Anatol Bogendorfer, Marija Milovanovic, Oona Valarie Serbest) summarized their decision as follows: "The real story, in which a man under the influence of drugs 30 years ago in Mexico declared himself a god and committed a mass murder, has been realized by Bernhard Hetzenauer in a very appealing and sophisticated way in LA SOMBRA DE UN DIOS. Beyond the content, the film is also convincing because of the precise and conscious way of dealing with the material and the medium of film. With the reduction to black and white, the filmmaker makes a political statement of the stereotypical, colorfully folkloric depictions of the indigenous population of Mexico."
