FESTIVAL AWARDS 2019

The **award ceremony for the sixteenth edition** of the CROSSING EUROPE filmfestival Linz took place today in the Ursulinensaal in the Upper Austrian Culture Quarter, the ceremony was hosted by Karin Schmid who led the audience through the evening.

In attendance of various international film guests, industry representatives and press, representatives for the various funders and sponsors, as well as politicians – a.o. state governor *Thomas Stelzer*, city councilor *Doris Lang-Mayerhofer*, councilor *Almir Balihodzic*, head of the gfk *Wiltrud Katharina Hackl, Patrick Bartos* (Managing Director of the Creative Region Linz & Upper Austria), *Marco Zinz* (Managing Director of The Grand Post – Audio & Picture Post Production), and *Alexander Fischbacher* (Managing Partner at The Grand Post – Audio & Picture Post Production), *Andreas Ungerböck* (ray Filmmagazin), and the artistic director of the Upper Austrian Culture Quarter *Martin Sturm* – the **CROSSING EUROPE AWARDS** (money and material prizes valued at **circa 30,000 €**) were awarded. The festival director Christine Dollhofer drew a preliminary resume of the festival that turned out to be quite positive.
